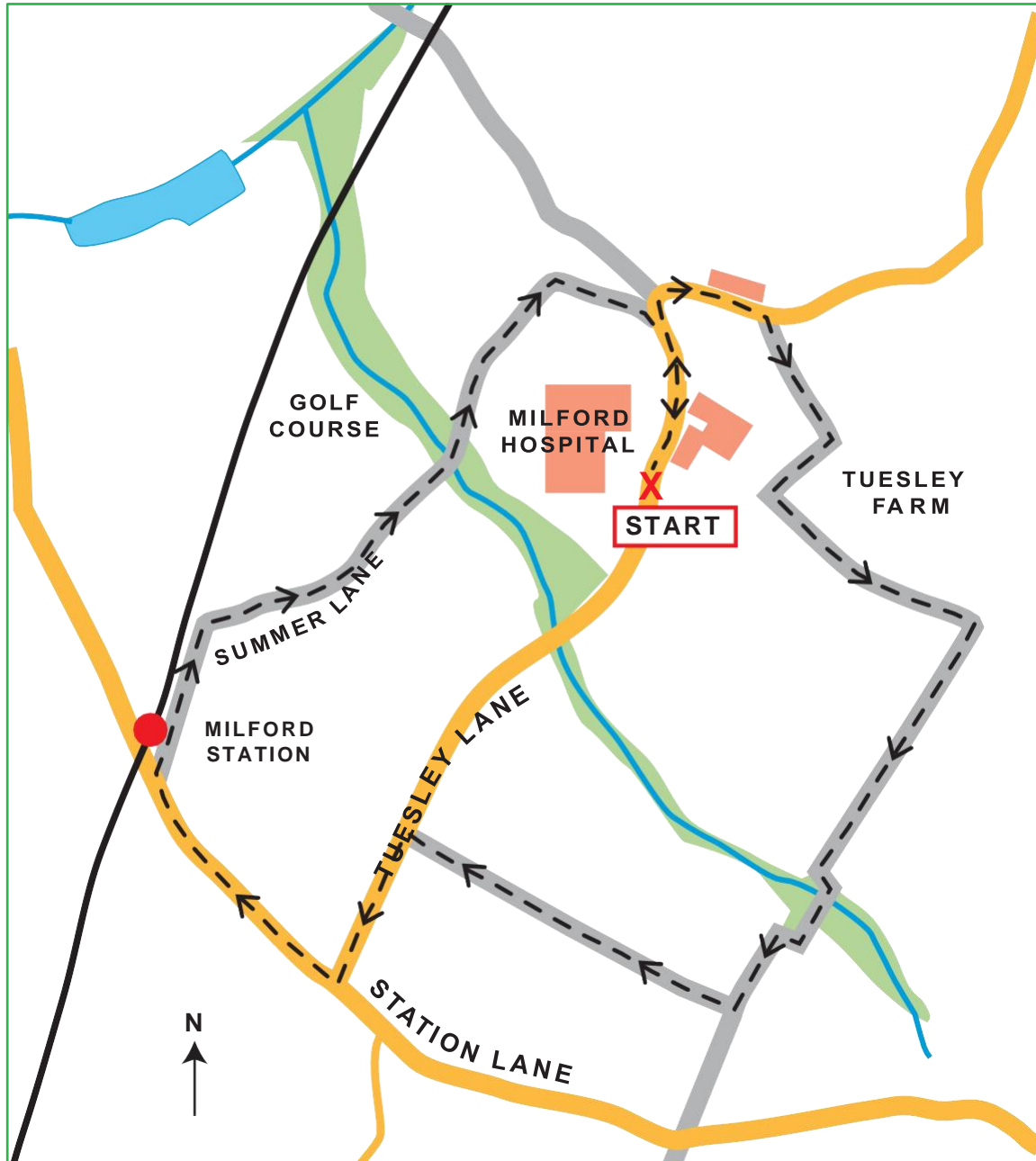








# Walk 1

## Summer Soft Fruits Trail

### Milford Station & Tuesley Farm

**Start:** Tuesley Lane – lay-by beside Milford Hospital

**Grid Ref:** SU963418

**Distance:** 3 miles

## Directions

Walk northwards along Tuesley Lane, taking care on the bends as you begin to descend, until you reach a house with a dovecote and a post box in the wall on your left. Take the footpath off to the right up some stone steps to a small gate at the top of the slope. Pass through the gate and continue ahead, passing a steep valley and then a pond on your left and a hedge on your right. Turn right at the end of the hedge, following FP sign.

You are now walking through Tuesley Farm and you can see, close up, the farm's soft fruit industry including strawberries, raspberries and blueberries. Follow the track along the hedge line; after it turns left, look out for FP and Raspberry Ramble (RR) signs and take the second track to the right. Follow this track past poly tunnels and growing areas and go down slope to a wooded area. Turn left, following the FP/RR signs, and shortly turn right through a gate, through woodland and over a stream. Exit the woodland through another gate and turn right.

Look out for a FP/RR sign to the left and follow the path through high hedges. Go straight over a crossing track and turn right at the RR sign. Please note that some of the signs may be obscured by hedge growth. Continue to follow RR/Tuesley Farm Community Path signs, alongside growing areas. Follow this signposted route to Tuesley Lane, emerging by a sign marked 'Tuesley Farm Community Path'.

When you emerge on to Tuesley Lane cross the road and turn left on the broad pedestrian/cycle path, which swings right at the junction with Station Lane and continues to Milford Station. Just before the level crossing, turn right along a lane, a private road but also a public footpath. The railway line and then the golf course are now on your left, with the fields of Tuesley Farm on your right.

After you pass a cottage on your left, the footpath keeps straight ahead and narrows, first descending a little, then climbing through a gully with a stream at the bottom. The path now runs along the boundary of the housing development, Leithfield Park on the right. Continue straight on the path to the end of the estate and, at a T junction, turn right. On this path you will shortly reach Tuesley Lane. Turn right here to retrace your steps back to your starting point.
